The City of Midland will hold the following public meeting on the city's community development program:

For the 2016/17 program, \$661,412 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development was allocated to the City. The City expects a similar amount for 2017/18. A minimum 70% of CDBG funds must be allocated to projects that benefit low and moderate-income persons. Examples of activities eligible for CDBG funding are: housing rehabilitation, sidewalk and street improvement, park improvements, code enforcement, lot clearance, economic development and public services.
