

**ORDER TERMINATING
THE ORDER DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER
FOR THE CITY OF MIDLAND, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, Governor Greg Abbott issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster in all counties in Texas due to the imminent threat of disaster posed by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, Mayor Patrick N. Payton (the "Mayor") issued an order declaring a local state of disaster for the City of Midland, Texas (the "Local Declaration") due to the imminent threat of disaster posed by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, the City Council ratified the Local Declaration and approved its continuation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor finds it to be in the public interest to terminate the Local Declaration;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, PROCLAIMED AND DECLARED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MIDLAND, TEXAS:

- 1.) That the Local Declaration is hereby terminated effective immediately, and it shall be of no further force or effect.
- 2.) That pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this order shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

It is hereby **ORDERED, PROCLAIMED AND DECLARED** this 12 day of May, 2020.
