

Water Conservation Tips



Sweep It Away

Use a broom, not the hose to clean up sidewalks and driveways.



Stop, Look & Listen

Check pipes, faucets, and toilets for leaks.



Be a Drip

Drip systems pinpoint water to roots.



Fix Your Leaks

Promptly repair broken or leaky sprinkler head and systems.



Keep off the Sidewalk

Water your lawn, not the pavement!



Turn Them Off

Turn off sprinklers when the forecast calls for rain.



Mulch and Save

Minimize evaporation with organic mulch.



Install Sensors

Add rain sensors and freeze gauges to existing systems.



Double Duty

Use old water from the fish tank to fertilize plants.



Don't Waste Time

A pinhole leak wastes up to 170 gallons a day.



Save the Rain

Store it for garden watering.



Time of Day Matters

From April 1 to Oct. 31 water only before 10 a.m. or after 6 p.m. when using sprinklers.
