

Code Enforcement WOW Report

May 2025

On April 29, 2025, Code Officer in Training Nick Spain, spotted badly faded striping at the busy HEB/Starbucks lot at Wadley & Midkiff — a clear code violation. He issued a notice, set expectations, and by May 10th, the lot was fully re-striped and 100% compliant. Fast action. Full compliance. Case closed. Another win for safety, order, and results-driven code enforcement.



On May 10, 2025, Code Officer in Training Nick Spain coordinated with our incredible Code and Solid Waste teams to launch a major cleanup operation in Washington Park — and we absolutely crushed it.

In just 4 hours, we:

- Cleared 4.38 tons of bulky junk
- Filled 2 open-tops, maxed out the claw truck, and loaded a hand truck
- Hit hotspots like Madison & Carver, Tyler & Lee, Tilden & Lincoln, and Calhoun & Tilden
- We hauled off everything — couches, appliances, furniture, lumber, even tree limbs.

This wasn't just cleanup — it was transformation. Fast, focused, and impactful. Leadership in action. Community elevated. Mission accomplished.

On Jan 9, 2025, Code Officer Billy Bill opened a case for a property overrun with weeds and debris. After two notices and a direct call, the owner not only cleaned up—she decided to demolish the entire structure. He granted extensions, stayed on top of it, and by May 13, the property was gone. From blight to blank slate, He drove this one from start to finish.



After multiple complaints about heavy debris and rubbish, our Code team — led by Code Officer Bill — took swift, decisive action.

- Initial report received: February 25, 2025
- Abatement notice issued: April 17, 2025
- Cleanup completed: May 16, 2025

With support from our Code Field Specialist, we fully cleared the front and backyard — turning a long-standing nuisance into a clean, compliant property.

On March 31, 2025, Code Officer Tony Molinar spotted a collapsed wall and damaged sign at 4200 Andrews Hwy. He immediately documented the scene, opened a debris case, and coordinated with the clinic manager. Within hours, He sent a formal repair notice to the property owner. Thanks to his fast response, the property manager moved quickly—repairs were bid out, cleanup began, and reconstruction followed soon after. By May 20, 2025, the wall was fully restored and looked better than ever. Tony's early intervention drove the entire resolution from start to finish.



On May 21, 2025, Code Field Supervisor Alexis Gonzales received a call from Code Manager Louis Gonzales about weed and litter issues at The Tailgate (4401 N Big Spring St, Midland, TX). By 9:00 AM the next day, the team was on-site. We completed a full abatement—removing all rubbish and weeds—by 2:28 PM. We captured before and after-photos to document the clean-up. Fast response, efficient execution, and another property restored to code.
