City of Midland Fifth Year Action Plan for 2024/2025 Community Development and Housing Funds

The City of Midland has prepared the 2024/2025 (October 1, 2024, to September 30, 2025) Action Plan Amendment to the Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan establishes Midland's long-range strategy for investment of its U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) resources and other service needs linked to activities directed at community development, housing, and homeless service needs. The Consolidated Plan covers a five-year period beginning October 1, 2020, and ending September 30, 2025.

The primary funding source is the City's 2024/2025 CDBG entitlement allocation, and program income totaling \$1,500,807 and CDBG CV-19 entitlement allocations of \$17,396 totaling \$1,518,203.

CDBG Fund Programs:

The CDBG Action Plan Amendment provides information on the locations of the proposed activities. The City anticipates that 80% of funds will benefit low and moderate-income persons. The Plan includes a narrative addressing a variety of issues and required certifications. The agency responsible for development of the Plan is the Community Development Division of the City's Development Services Department.
