- Wednesday, October 12<sup>th</sup>: 9:00 am Poster Contest Award Ceremony at Central Fire Station
- October 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, & 16<sup>th</sup>: Finalist's posters will be on display at the Midland Park Mall

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ◆ Only work completed by each individual student will be accepted
- ◆ One entry per student
- ◆ Posters may be completed on any phase of Fire Prevention
- ◆ **THE ONLY POSTER SIZE ACCEPTABLE** is 14 by 22 inches (1/2 a poster board)
- ◆ No 3 dimensional objects over 1/2 inch thickness or height may be placed/affixed on the posters
- ◆ Do **NOT** use matches, real glass in any form or scorch the paper
- ◆ The following information must be placed on the back of the poster in the lower right hand corner
