2. Person(s), who have responsibility to ensure SWPPP compliance for a site for permit conditions.

Why is Total Area needed?

Sites that are less than 1 acre are not required to apply for coverage to discharge stormwater from a construction site.

Sites more than 1 acre but less than 5 are required to have a prepared SWPPP and small site notice posted at entrance of site. (** Sites that are part of larger common plan of development are required to submit application to discharge to TCEQ for separate operators**)

Sites 5 acres or greater are required to have TPDES permit to the state and SWPPP prepared detailing the scope and many actions to take place during the process of the construction process on the site.
